Following a public hearing held virtually on April 27, 2022, the Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) has announced its decision to renew SRB Technologies (Canada) Inc.'s (SRBT) Nuclear Substance Processing Facility Operating Licence for a period of 12 years.

This represents the longest licence term in SRBT's history, as well as the **longest licence term granted** by the Commission for the operation of a Class 1 facility in Canada.

The renewed licence authorizes SRBT to continue operating its gaseous tritium light source (GTLS) manufacturing facility, and to distribute GTLS and radiation devices in Canada and internationally, with no substantive changes to the licensing basis.

Based on the evidence provided, the Commission is satisfied that SRBT has adequate programs and measures in place to ensure that the health and safety of workers, the public and the environment will be protected over the 12-year licence term.

We would like to take this opportunity to thank our dedicated staff for their hard work and continuous commitment to safe operations under the oversight of CNSC staff. We would also like to thank our customers and local organizations who provided their support during the licence renewal process.

Over the 12-year licence term, we will continue to operate the facility safely, to strive to further lower emissions, and to improve the effectiveness of our programs and processes. We will also continue to supply products for commercial, military, aerospace and scientific applications, with a focus on contributing to the safety of people in situations where reliable illumination is needed.

We are committed to continue to build relationships with Indigenous Nations and communities in the vicinity of our facility, and we will remain transparent and open by continuing to share information on our operations through the company website and social media outlets.
